Students will also review core curriculum identified by AHIMA as essential domains of learning and includes RHIT and CCA practice exams.

3. Develop and submit a sufficiently focused and relevant Capstone Project Proposal.
4. Plan and Implement the approved Capstone project.
5. Execute the approved Capstone project to completion.
6. Produce and present the completed approved Capstone project.
