Description

Introduces the Ichishkin language of the Warm Springs (Sahaptin) people. First course of a three-term sequence of study of the Native American language, Ichishkin, at the first-year college level. The first term will introduce students to alphabet characters, sounds, and simple phrases.

Learning outcomes

1. Recognize the sound system of Ichishkin.
2. Use basic vocabulary and a variety of simple phrases.
3. Initiate and respond to simple requests for information.
4. Demonstrate the inter-relatedness of language and culture.

- Greetings and small conversations
- Daily routines and household activities
- Colors and clothing
- Face and body parts
- Eating and drinking
