

CORE TRANSFER MAPS

Core Transfer Maps offer a standardized statewide framework of 30 credits. These credits fulfill general education requirements for a bachelor's degree at any Oregon public university. Students who complete these credits are guaranteed they will count towards their degree requirements.

Students who know their major are encouraged to consult with an academic advisor while choosing their Core Transfer Map courses. This guidance ensures that students select classes that not only align with their transfer goals but also contribute to the lower-division requirements of their intended major, keeping them on track for timely completion of their four-year degree.
