

GENERAL EDUCATION

General Education Purpose

General education's purpose is to help students develop habits of mind that lead to thoughtful and productive global citizenship. The College includes general education requirements in each degree intended to prepare students to transfer to earn a bachelor's degree; general education is divided into foundational requirements (writing, oral communication, mathematics, and health/wellness/fitness) and discipline studies (cultural literacy, arts and letters, social sciences, and science/math/computer science). All courses in these categories have been approved as meeting the statewide general education student learning outcomes at the time of approval.

COCC Institutional Outcomes

The College developed institutional outcomes that are based on the student learning outcomes for all general education courses at Oregon community colleges (these outcomes are provided below). The purpose of COCC's institutional outcomes is to maintain the statewide general education learning objectives while also streamlining them to be more observable and/or measurable for the purposes of assessment. These institutional outcomes are used for all general education instructional assessment at COCC.

Foundational Course Outcomes

Health

- Explain the relationship between human behavior and health.

Mathematics

- Apply appropriate mathematics to solve problems and interpret results.

Speech/Oral Communication

- Communicate effectively and ethically for a variety of audiences.

Writing

- Read actively, think critically, and write purposefully and capably for academic and, in some cases, professional audiences.
- Demonstrate appropriate reasoning in response to complex issues.

Information Literacy

- Evaluate information resources in response to an information need.

Discipline Studies Course Outcomes

Arts & Letters

- Create or evaluate works of human expression using discipline-appropriate methods.

Cultural Literacy

- Analyze complex practices, values, and beliefs and the culturally and historically defined meanings of difference.

Science

- Evaluate a hypothesis using qualitative or quantitative data.

Computer Science

- Create algorithms and computer programs that solve problems.

Social Science

- Apply analytical skills to social phenomena in order to understand human behavior.

Health

1. Explain the relationship between human behavior and health.

Mathematics

1. Use appropriate mathematics to solve problems; and
2. Recognize which mathematical concepts are applicable to a scenario, apply appropriate mathematics and technology in its analysis, and then accurately interpret, validate, and communicate the results.

Science or Computer Science

1. Gather, comprehend, and communicate scientific and technical information in order to explore ideas, models and solutions and generate further questions;
2. Apply scientific and technical modes of inquiry, individually, and collaboratively, to critically evaluate existing or alternative explanations, solve problems, and make evidence-based decisions in an ethical manner; and
3. Assess the strengths and weaknesses of scientific studies and critically examine the influence of scientific and technical knowledge on human society and the environment.

Social Science

1. Apply analytical skills to social phenomena in order to understand human behavior; and
2. Apply knowledge and experience to foster personal growth and better appreciate the diverse social world in which we live.

Speech/Oral Communication

1. Engage in ethical communication processes that accomplish goals;
2. Respond to the needs of diverse audiences and contexts; and
3. Build and manage relationships.

Writing and Information Literacy

1. Read actively, think critically, and write purposefully and capably for academic and, in some cases, professional audiences;
2. Recognize and articulate the need for information, and then locate, evaluate, and ethically utilize that information to communicate effectively; and
3. Demonstrate appropriate reasoning in response to complex issues.
