# **GRAPHIC DESIGN - ONE-YEAR CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION** (CC1)

### Description

The Graphic Design One-Year Certificate of Completion provides a thorough foundation in the fundamentals of Graphic Design: color, typography, composition and their application using industrystandard approaches. Students apply current production methods and techniques to relevant projects that consider branding and target market. Courses cover unique aspects of Graphic Design including print and digital designs, vector art and graphics, digital photography, and brand/ style guide development. This combination of courses is intended to give students the knowledge and skill set to augment their transfer degree and/or initiate a career as a freelance or entry level graphic designer.

### **Program Learning Outcomes**

Upon successful completion of the certificate, students will be able to:

- 1. Create designs with industry standard software.
- 2. Model effective and professional communication when collaborating with industry professionals and clients.
- 3. Produce a portfolio that demonstrates the variety of skills and creativity developed.
